Question

Answer

1. The document referes to deliverables in the form of study, policy brief, case studies which will feature on the CDKN website or other suitable platforms. Can you please clarify the specific end use and the specific users of these different products —is the primary audience for the research and the products the Political Champions Group?	The Political Champions group is one key audience for this research. However, the lessons learnt from this project will be more widely applicable and we are keen for deliverables to be suitable also for broader policy, public sector and academic audiences.
2. The deadline for submission of the bids is 16 January. With the first deliverable on 16 February, when do you envision making the award?	We anticipate that bidders will be notified of our decision on Monday 21 st January.
3. Page 7 –Timeframe –refers to the potential for an extensinon of activities beyond the June date if additional components are added at a later time –can you provide an example of this?	This might include presenation/ participation at an additional workshop, production of visual media as an additional output, or other activities. However, there are no concrete plans for any extension of activities at this stage.
4. What is the minimum number of case examples that are expected or will be acceptable?	There is no minimum as such. It is up to the bidder to set out the number of case studies, and the focus and scope of those case studies to be included in this work.
5. The tender has a three part emphasis with respect to 1.] an analysis and demonstration of how the private sector can engage in and strengthen resilience in the context of disasters and climate extremes (looking at motives, roles, opportunities and constraints), 2] an analysis of the constraints and incentives for the private sector to engage in disaster reslience and climat change adaptation –which of course will be different for local private sector and MNCs and 3] and documenting examples of innovative public- private partnerships for DRM and climate change adapatation –which shifts the focus more to the modes of and models of engagement and collaboration. What is the balance of emphasis between these themes?	The main focus is on the third of these 3, however the project will need to comprehensively address the first 2 in order to achieve this.
