We recommend adding a photo of yourself, and please include your Wikipedia username behind your profile name (so we knnow who is who and we can put a welcome message on your talk page).



















Top tips for using Slack




Use the "Reply in thread" function to respond to comments. This will make it easier to organise all comments and to keep conversations focused on one topic.



You must however select "follow thread" to be notified of any new messages within a thread.



Use the "share" function when you want to respond to a comment or highlight something within a thread with the entire channel.



@ mentions are a useful way to make sure a specific person is alerted to your message.

















Slack Wiki4Climate workspace



Make sure you use the right channel:

- Announcements and resources: Announcements relating to Wiki4Climate and additional resources to help with Wikipedia editing will be shared on this channel.
- Editing comments and questions: Use this channel for any chat, comments and questions related to editing.
- Intros and networking: Use this channel for introductions and networking and connecting with your fellow Wikipedia editors.

- React to the welcome message on your talk page talk pages are the number 1 tool to communicate with other Wikipedians
- Put your name next to 1 or several articles on the project page you will need to know how to work with source editor (wikitext)
- Write on the talk page of your article of interest what you intend changing
- Write in the Slack channel "editing comments" what articles you plan to focus on (we will add your username to the article/s on the project page)
- Collaborate on specific topics of mutual interest Give us updates in Slack and the daily check-ins



6 recommended tasks



1	Add reliable citations	 WikiProject CC guide to reliable sources Citation Hunt, or add directly Page 31 of guide & video tutorials
2	Improve language, readability and lengths of leads	 Exec summary or abstract of article Wikipedia Manual of Style Section 4.6 of guide & video tutorials
3	Improve language, readability of parts or the entire article	 Various readability tools Tips on readability Section 4.6 of guide & video tutorials
4	Add more or better figures, images, videos or wiki links	 Many articles lack figures and images Add from Wikimedia commons Wikipedia guidance and video tutorials
5	Expand articles about climate change topics	 Refer to article tables on project page Section 4.6 of guide and video tutorials
6	Add more content about countries in the Global South	 Many articles lack content about the Global South Section 4.6 of guide and video tutorials

Certificates and prizes



- Certificates for participants who make at least 10 good edits to the English Wikipedia
- A "good edit" is one that does not need to be reverted
- Value of USD 50 in vouchers (exchanged in local currency where applicable)
- At least will be awarded to women and Global South participants

Certificates and prizes

The most valuable contributions will be judged by a combination of the following criteria:


- The quality of the edit, including depth of information added
- The quantity of the edits
- Providing information related to the Global South
- Bonus points will be given for editors who have added content relating to gender and social inclusion concerns
