Background of the Group

In November 2011, International Centre for Climate Change and Development (ICCCAD)

and International Institute for Environment and Development (IIED) organized short а training course on Planning, Implementing Mainstreaming and Adaptation into Government

Programmes. The course was for Government Officials from developing countries. Since climate change is a new subject for many government officials

having to develop and implement such plans,

there is a need for training on how to plan, implement and ultimately mainstream climate change into national and sectoral development plans and program. Therefore, the aim was for participants to leave the course with greater knowledge, networks and continued support from experts to feel sufficiently knowledgeable, confident and empowered to return to their workplaces and initiate activities. Participants agreed to work together on a joint working paper on the topic. Subsequently, IIED obtained funding from Climate and Development Knowledge Network (CDKN) to support some of the ICCCAD course participants in attending the CBA6¹ conference in Hanoi, Vietnam and to attend a write shop to work on the joint paper.

The write shop was facilitated by Nanki Kaur and Jessical Ayers of IIED.In CBA6, a sub-

group named 'Government Group on Mainstreaming Climate Change in Planning' was formed. It consists of government officials who were in Hanoi and those who attended the ICCCAD course last November 2011.

Future Scope for the Government Group

Training: ICCCAD will hold a second short course on 'Mainstreaming Climate Change

participants of the first course as well as some new participants (mainly from Africa).

CBA7: CBA7 will be held in 2013 and will focus on Mainstreaming CBA in National and
