

## GAME PLAY INSTRUCTIONS

Please elaborate your answers as you get into character! Share your character's thoughts and feelings with the group.

The Climate Change Officer comes to visit.

She saw you at the consultation meeting. You remind her about your main concerns about the flooding.

How has the neighbourhood flooding affected you and what would improve your situation? Explain that the information about flood risks is very poor. You would be more pro-active about flood preparation if you received good information.

You're strong and healthy so you're in a good position to protect your property and family if disaster threatens . . . .



Round One

You attend the neighbourhood meeting, everyone comes.

There is an idea for an organised network of volunteers in Barrio Inundado that would support residents who need practical help during future floods.

This sounds good to you: you could put in time and physical labour.

You are motivated: if everyone cooperates to reduce the impacts of flooding, you will get a better price when you are ready to sell your house.

However, you're wondering why the indigenous woman in the meeting looks nervous about joining in mixed male-female volunteer groups, and the young gay guy seems unsettled.
